The ideal candidate is calm under pressure, trauma-informed, and passionate about helping young people build pathways to independence.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide supportive case management and crisis intervention to youth residents during night hours.
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all residents by conducting regular room checks and maintaining a secure environment.
- Respond promptly to incidents, conflicts, or emergencies, following agency protocols.
- Monitor adherence to house rules and curfews, providing guidance and coaching when necessary.
- Maintain clear and timely documentation of nightly activities, incidents, and resident interactions.
- Communicate effectively with day shift staff to ensure continuity of care.
- Support residents with basic needs (e.g., hygiene items, food access) during overnight hours.
- Provide informal mentoring and emotional support when youth need a listening ear or guidance.
- Participate in staff meetings, training, and supervision as required.



Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent required; associate or bachelor's degree in social work, Psychology, Youth Development, or related field preferred.
- Minimum 1 year of experience working with at-risk youth or in a shelter/residential setting.
- Ability to work independently, manage crisis situations calmly, and maintain appropriate professional boundaries.
- Excellent interpersonal, problem-solving, and communication skills.
- Must pass background check and possess or be willing to obtain CPR/First Aid certification.
